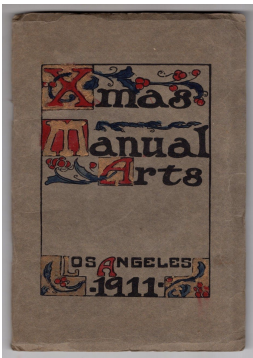

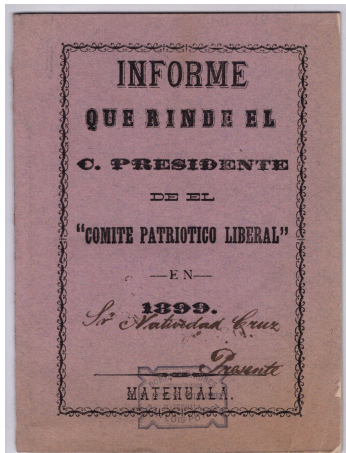

Manual Arts High School was founded in 1910 " in the middle of bean fields ", according to Wikipedia. It was the third high school in Los Angeles, California. One of the school's first teachers, Ethel Percy Andrus (1911 - 1915), leaving the school to become e California's first woman high school principal, later founding AARP. 66p. + 6 pages ads in printed, hand-illuminated Nouveau styled wrappers.

The program featured an introduction by Archibald MacLeish and reading by T.S. Eliot. Lightly toned, some surface wear, not a perfect copy, but an unusual Eliot item. Good. Staplebound. Envelope addressed to mexican politician Fernando Lopez and family, with enclosure for response. Program 4p., leaflet with order of music and representatives.

Matehuala: 1899. 17p. + one folding chart. 8-1/4" x 6-1/4" inches. Printed lavender wraps. Signed in ink "Sr. Natividad Cruz, Presente", also inscribed in 1944 on first leaf. At the turn of the century, in resistance to the Diaz regime, Liberal clubs were forming and meeting secretly in Mexican cities to discuss politics. This pamphlet was likely printed in preparation for the First Liberal Congress that met in San Luis Potosí in 1901. Very good. Wraps. (1981) \$220.00

Unusual title, limited to five copies in domestic holdings. 13" x 16". Very good. Hardcover. (1959) \$200.00
